

HOWEVER ONE DESCRIBES THE SYMPTOM, IS ONE OF THE MAIN REASONS FOR VETERINARIAN CONSULTATIONS BY PET OWNERS

It can take different forms: scratching with the paws, biting, licking, rubbing on a wall, head-shakes, twitches, irritability or aggressiveness...

All animals scratch more or less on and off and it is considered normal behavior to a moderate extent without causing any skin lesions (redness, crust, infections, etc). It is crucial to consult your veterinarian in order to identify the cause.




