Signs of Hypoglycemia

- Lethargy
- Weakness
- **Head Tilting**
- "Drunkedness" wobbling when walking, unbalanced
- Hunger
- Convulsions or seizures
- Shivering
- Ataxia usually lack of muscular coordination, but may be changes in head and neck movements
- Disorientation
- Stupor
- Restlessness
- Coma

BE PREPARED

If your pet is showing any of these signs, call us immediately and give your pet a form of sugar orally.

Always have corn syrup available (light Karo), pancake syrup, honey, or table sugar dissolved in water if needed in an emergency
