

Signs of Hypoglycemia



Lethargy



Weakness



Head Tilting



“Drunkedness” – wobbling when walking, unbalanced



Hunger



Convulsions or seizures



Shivering



Ataxia – usually lack of muscular coordination, but may be changes in head and neck movements



Disorientation



Stupor



Restlessness



Coma

BE PREPARED

If your pet is showing any of these signs, call us immediately and give your pet a form of sugar orally.

Always have corn syrup available (light Karo), pancake syrup, honey, or table sugar dissolved in water if needed in an emergency
